Scholarship Application Package

About

Every year, two \$2000 scholarships are awarded to eligible students who have worked to achieve the highest standards in academic studies, extra-curricular and community involvement. Complete applications must be received by CRPEG no later than July 20.

Eligibility

- 1. Applicants for this award must either be:
 - a. A child or grandchild of any current or past member of CRPEG, or
 - b. A graduate of any secondary school within an 85 km radius of Chalk River Laboratories.
- 2. Applicants must be entering their first year of post-secondary education, in a full-time post-secondary program at a Canadian educational institution (including CÉGEPs).

Criteria

Applicants will be evaluated based on recent:

- Academic accomplishments
- Extra-curricular activities
- · Community involvement

Applicants will also be evaluated on their motivation for pursuing higher education.

Awarding

The selection of successful applicants is performed by the CRPEG Scholarship Committee, which is appointed by the CRPEG Executive. CRPEG will notify the successful applicants by mid-September. Each successful applicant is then required to provide CRPEG with confirmation of enrolment in a post-secondary institution. After CRPEG has accepted the confirmation of enrolment, a cheque will be forwarded to the selected recipient. If acceptable confirmation of enrolment at a post-secondary institution is not provided, the application may be rejected.

Required Information

The following information is required to be included in each scholarship application:

- 1. A completed scholarship application form (the final page of this application package).
- 2. A copy of an official transcript from the educational institution most recently attended by the applicant.
- 3. A document describing:
 - a. The applicant's recent academic accomplishments, extracurricular activities, and community involvement.
 - b. The post-secondary program the applicant will attend, including the name of the Canadian educational institution and the program's length.
 - c. The applicant's motivation for pursuing higher education.
- 4. Three (3) letters of reference supporting that the applicant is deserving of this scholarship.

Submission

Applications must be received by CRPEG no later than July 20. Upon receiving an application, CRPEG will review it for completeness. CRPEG will then attempt to contact the applicant and provide the status of the application (complete/accepted or incomplete/rejected).

CRPEG may use the names and photos of recipients, along with their post-secondary institution and program, in promotional material.
